

## Discussion Questions for Book Clubs

#### Book Club Discussion Questions

Thanks for choosing *The Glow of Death* for your book club! After you've made the featured drink and toasted one another with Josie's dad's favorite toast: "Here's to silver light in the dark of night," you're ready to discuss the book! Here are a few questions to get you started:

1. There's significant evidence that Clara Driscoll, not Louis Comfort Tiffany, designed the lamps known as "Tiffany lamps," including the wisteria lamp. She had to stop working at the Tiffany studio when she remarried, because married women weren't allowed to work there. Have you ever been unable to do something you wanted to do because of your gender?

2. If you could live anywhere, would you want to live in Rocky Point, New Hampshire?
3. In the book, Josie reflects on New Hampshire. Here's an excerpt: *New Hampshire was beautiful in all seasons, from the fiery colors of autumn to the pristine whites of winter to the red buds and unfurled green leaves of spring, but it was summer I liked the most. The buttercups, and violets, and honeysuckle that line the winding country roads. The feathery grasses and wild roses along the sandy dunes. The wildflowers that spread like rainbows across the meadows. The easy breezes. I was a sucker for a breeze.* What do you like best about where you live?
4. Follow-up question: If you could live anywhere, where would that be?
5. Josie struggles to remember what the fake Ava looked like. Do you trust your memory?
6. What do you think about Josie and Ty's relationship? Do you like where it's headed?
